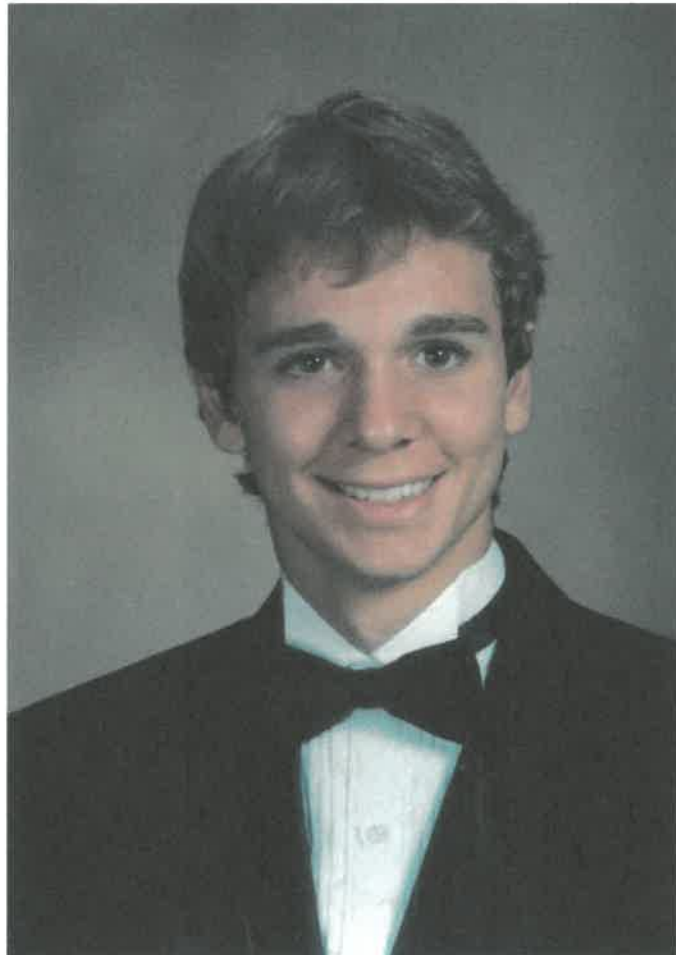

Pat Baldiserra won 6 varsity letters in soccer and tennis as a student athlete at Buena Regional High School. Pat was a three time 1st Team Cape Atlantic League all-star selection and an All South Jersey selection in soccer. During his senior year, Pat was picked as a first team All-State all-star selection. After graduation, Pat attended Rutgers University Camden where he continued his soccer career. He garnered the honors of the New Jersey Athletic Conference first team selection in his first three years and a two-time National Soccer Coaches Association of America All Metro all-star. On June 26, 2007, Pat was fatally injured in a car accident. The following year, Pat's family, friends and teammates started a soccer alumni game in his memory. The "Play for Pat" event raises money for scholarships in his honor. Scholarship money is awarded to a male and female soccer player every year.

The 2008 team paved the way and started a Buena tradition.

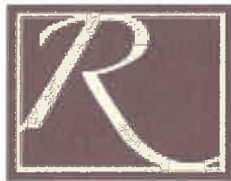

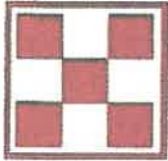
