Coach-Boys Track & Field, Girls Track & Field, Boys Cross-Country

Buena Regional School District, 1980-1987

Jim Marketto was a three-sport coach for eight years at Buena Regional High School. He taught for 17 years in the Buena Regional School District. Jim coached boys cross-country from 1980-1986, boys track and field in 1981 and 1987 and girls track and field from 1982-1986. Jim's boys cross-country team was undefeated in 1984, garnering the Cape Atlantic League II and Atlantic County championships. In 1986, the cross-country team was also Atlantic County champions. Jim's girls track and field team was undefeated and was Cape Atlantic League II champions in 1985 and 1986. The girls 1986 team captured the South Jersey Group II championship. A graduate of Vineland High School, class of 1965, where he is a VHS Wall of Fame member for the 1964 Group IV State Championship Team running member of the boys cross-country team. Jim is also a member of the Gloucester County College Hall of Fame for coaching the 1995 men's cross-country team as the NJCAA Division III National Champions. He was also named coach of the year for that accolade. Jim graduated from Glassboro State College in 1969 and is currently employed as an adjunct professor and academic advisor at Rowan College of South Jersey-Cumberland Campus. He presently resides in Millville, NJ with his wife Bernadette of 53 years. Jim is the proud father of daughters Krista and Karen and is also a grandfather to six grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

The Bridgeton Relays title also set the school record of 43.4 seconds. He was also part of the 4x200 meter relay team that captured first at the Bridgeton Relays. Bruce is a graduate of New Haven University, where he graduated with a BS and MS in Criminal Justice, and he also played football from 1996-1998. She was a 2001 and 2002 1st Team Cape Atlantic League and All South Jersey selection in track & field. Chelsea was a 2-time Cape Atlantic League meet champion in the javelin and broke the meet record during her junior year. She broke the javelin school record 6 times in 2001 and the discus school record at the State Meet of Champions. Chelsea was a 2001 The Press of Atlantic City, New Jersey All Group II and All State Team All-Star selection. She placed first in the javelin and fifth in the discus events at the New Jersey Meet of Champions. Thereafter in that same year, Chelsea competed in the High School Nationals where she placed fifth. Chelsea received her BAS in Kinesiology and Exercise Science from East Carolina University in 2007. She attended ECU on an athletic scholarship, where she was a member of the Track & Field Team. During her tenure at ECU, she was a one time All Conference USA team selection, a 1st place hammer thrower at the Conference USA meet and a 3-time 2nd place javelin event place winner. Also, she was ranked 5th in the nation for all collegiate hammer throwers and held the school record in the hammer throw from 2004-2006. Chelsea graduated from Rutgers University with an MBS in Kinesiology and Exercise Science in 2020. She is a Fitness Director for HealthQuest of Central New Jersey. 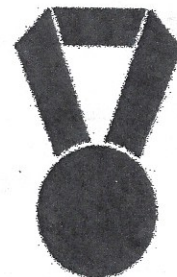
