



During his sophomore year, Kevin batted .521 and earned a 7-0 record on the mound during his junior year. He was a 1,000-point scorer in basketball during his senior season. In his final season in baseball in 12th grade, Kevin earned a 9-1 record as a pitcher on the mound, with a 0.76 ERA and 96 strikeouts. For his accolades in baseball, he was 1st Team All South Jersey, 1st Team All State, Daily Journal Player of the Year and Courier Post Co-Player of the Year. After high school, Kevin attended and played at Rowan College of South Jersey, where his team earned two trips to the Collegiate World Series. He was The Press of Atlantic City, Old Spice Red Zone Player of the Year, and the Joe Clements Outstanding Athlete Award during his senior season in football. He was the New Jersey Coaches Association Top 100 Selection for football and won the Nichterlein and McCabe “Old Grad” Award for the top athlete in Atlantic County in his senior year. Ken set the South Jersey record for points scored by a wide receiver with 49 and earned the Cape Atlantic League record for 17 touchdowns in a season and 24 in a career. He earned the BRHS school record for receptions, receiving yards and touchdowns in a game, season, and career. In baseball, Ken was a .386 career hitter and was a 2 time All Cape Atlantic League, All South Jersey, and All State Group II. 
