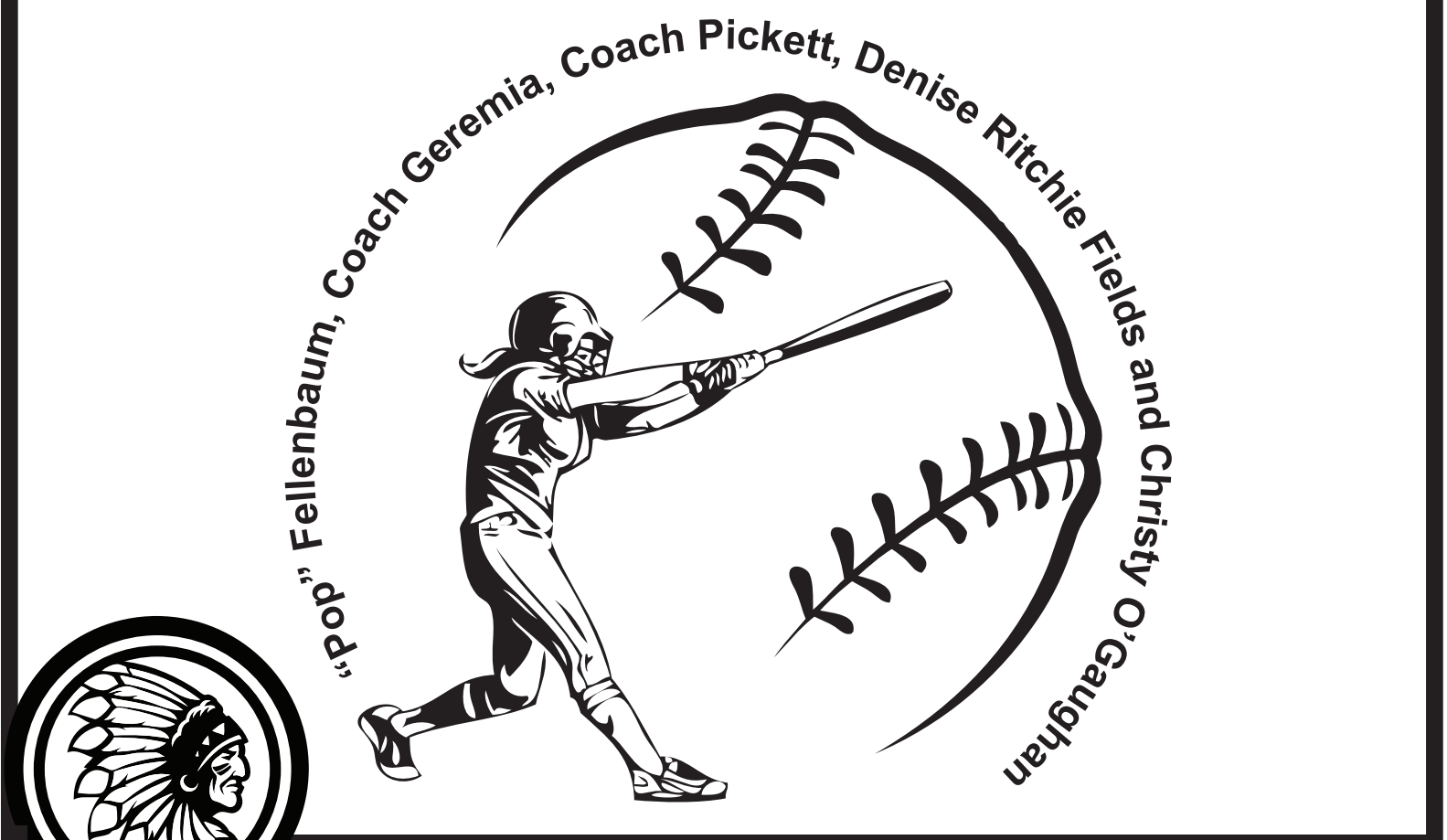

Pam Pickett

Coach-Softball, Field Hockey, Basketball

Buena Regional School District, 1980-Present

Pam Pickett has been a fixture at Buena Regional High School when she became an educator in 1980 and her commitment to girls' athletics began in 1981. She coached girls' basketball during the 1982-83 season and field hockey for the 1982-2007 seasons. Pam started coaching softball in 1981 serving as an assistant coach for seven years until she ultimately took over the program in 1988 where she built the Buena Softball program into the dynasty that exists today. For the past 35 seasons, Pam has impacted many lady athletes not only athletically, but academically and socially as well. She currently has 705 wins, is the winningest coach in South Jersey, has qualified for the South Jersey sectional tournament in all 35 seasons and has never had a season winning percentage less than 0.500. Pam was one of eight finalists for National Softball Coach of the Year in 2023, was inducted into the NJSIAA Coaches Hall of Fame in 2000 and the South Jersey Coaches Hall of Fame in 2003. She has won twenty-three Cape Atlantic League conference titles, two Betty Howell Classic Tournament titles, seven South Jersey sectional titles and one NJSIAA South-Central title, where the team captured state runner up accolades. In 2014, the Buena Softball field was named "Pickett Field." Pam's "Linked for Life" philosophy translates that Buena Softball teams are linked to the teams of the past and will be linked to the teams of the future. Pam was a catcher on the softball team at Glassboro State College and graduated in 1980. She presently resides in Newfield, NJ with her husband Tom of 25 years. Pam is the proud stepmother of Stephanie and Chad Guenther, Liz and Mark McLaughlin and Steven and Lar-el Carr and is also a grandmother to nine grandchildren.

Buena Regional School District, 1987-1998, 2013-2023

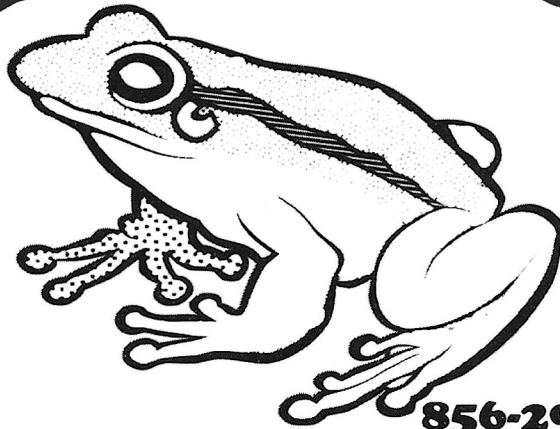

Class of 1999

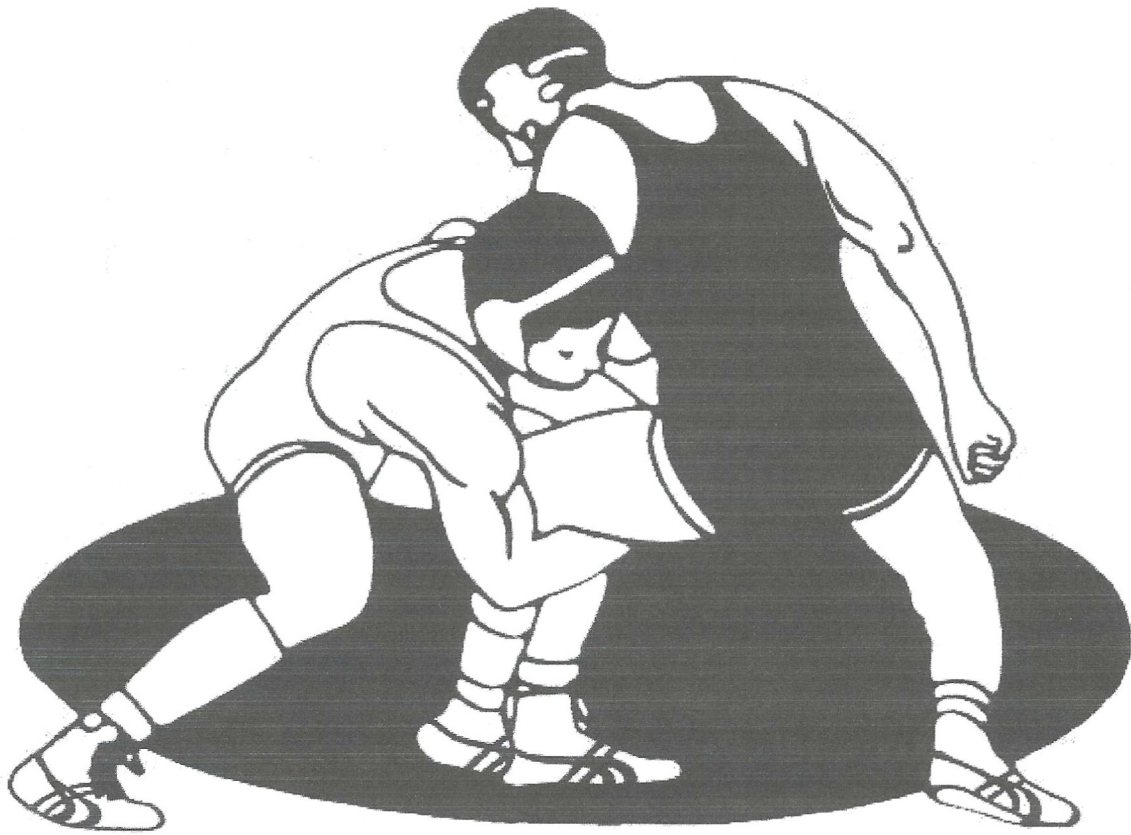
Basketball, Softball, Cheerleading, Athletic Trainer

The 1994 softball team was one of the most successful in school history. The team set a school record for victories (26) in a season, earned the Cape Atlantic League National Division I and National Conference title and captured the school's first ever Cape Atlantic League overall championship. The team tied a school record for twelve consecutive wins, set school records for the fourth consecutive CAL National I title and third consecutive CAL National Conference championship. The ladies ended up 10th in South Jersey as rated by the Courier Post and 8th in South Jersey rated by the Philadelphia Inquirer. Melissa Maxwell and Mary Veneziale were selected to All South Jersey honors and Maxwell, Veneziale and Christy Gaughan played in the Senior All Star game.
