# **Michael “Mickey” Caprice**

## **Supporter of Buena Athletics**

Michael “Mickey” Caprice was a devoted Buena Regional High School Athletics supporter, namely for the BRHS wrestling team. Mickey was the sole founder of the Buena Braves wrestling program, where he coached many successful and accomplished scholastic wrestlers throughout the midget program, high school level and collegiately. Mickey was a tenured tournament director of the NJSIAA District 32 wrestling tournament, where the tournament was a fixture in the Buena Chiefs gymnasium for many years. He was responsible for the first 3 Buena alumnus wrestlers to achieve the feat of All-American status while wrestling for their respective university wrestling teams. Mickey was a pee-wee football coach for the Buena Braves Athletic Association and a baseball coach for the Buena Little League. A school board member for the Buena Regional School District for an astounding 23 years, Mickey was selected for the prestigious Dr. J.P. Cleary Citizenship Award, an award presented to community members where their service rendered is of high quality, having a lasting effect on the community and service rendered is of the individual’s sacrifice, time and effort. Mickey is survived by his daughter, Michelle Carrera, son Domenic, granddaughters Diana and Nina and grandsons, Jake, Nick and Michael.

He was a four-time Cape Atlantic League all-star selection in wrestling. He won the Pennsauken Christmas Tournament, and his high school career record was 87-17. After graduation, he attended American University on a Division I wrestling scholarship. Dom was a four-year varsity letter winner at American and was also a team captain during his senior season. After graduation, Dom attended and completed his Doctor of Medicine in Dentistry at Fairleigh Dickinson School of Dental Medicine in 1986 and his Oral Maxillofacial Surgery training at Georgetown University Medical Center, which he completed in 1994. He is a Diplomat of the American Board of Oral Maxillofacial Surgery. Domenic is one of three oral surgeons at Vineland Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeons in Vineland, NJ. 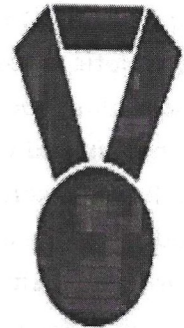

Shawn Smith earned seven varsity letters in football, basketball and track & field during his athletic career at Buena Regional High School. Shawn was an All-South Jersey and South Jersey Runner of the Year in 1989. He was a South Jersey and New Jersey Group II State Champion in the 100-meter and 200-meter races during his Junior and Senior track seasons. Shawn broke the school records for the 100 and 200-meter races. He was a contributing member of the boys' track team that won the Cape Atlantic League title in 1988 and 1989. Shawn was a standout member of the 1988 football team that captured the first in school history NJSIAA South Jersey Group II Sectional Championship. Shawn led the football squad that produced a perfect 11-0 record and outscored their opponents by a margin of 417-75. After graduation, he attended Notre Dame University on a Division I football scholarship. Shawn graduated from San Diego State University and played in the Canadian Football League. Shawn played for the Frankfurt Galaxy of the National Football League Europe where he and his teammates won an NFL Europe championship. He currently works in the transportation industry with American Airlines and is engaged to Nicole Swelto. The couple have three children: Ryan, Naijha and Suniya. The family resides in Charlotte, NC. Shawn's hobbies include sports, physical fitness and training, acquisition of knowledge through books and the American Descendants of Slavery (ADOS) advocacy.

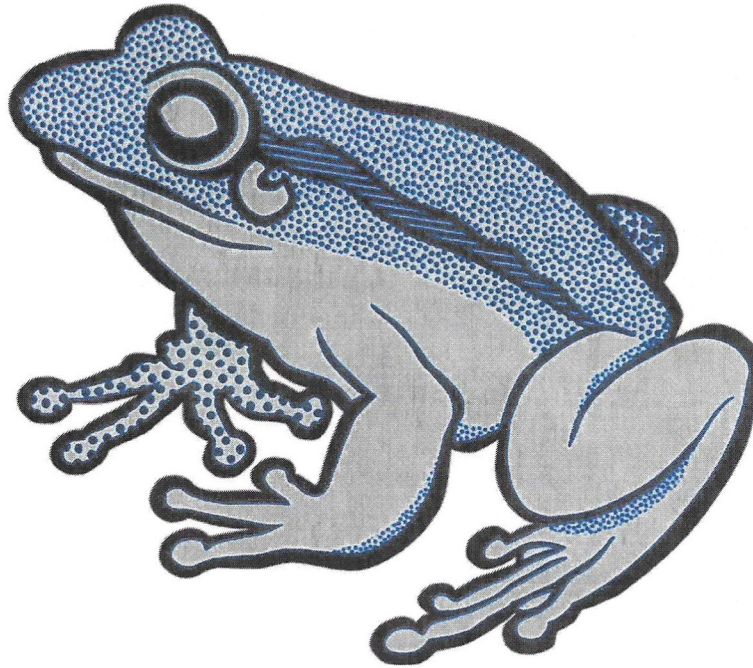
