Compounded Semaglutide Liquid for Sublingual Administration

The usage of GLP-1 receptor agonists has grown worldwide. This class includes several different injectable medications, as well as an orally delivered drug. Many patients would prefer to avoid injections if possible, and there is an extremely low absorption of oral tablets (less than 1% per the labeling for RYBELSUS®). For these reasons, and other potential valid reasons, prescribers and patients may prefer a patent-pending compounded formulation of Semaglutide.

What is Sublingual Semaglutide & How is it Different?

Sublingual (SL) Semaglutide is a compounded suspension of semaglutide that is designed to be administered under the tongue. Our formulation utilizes a special base designed with the intent to carry large molecules (high molecular weight substances), such as semaglutide, through the oral mucosal membrane. In a recent *in vitro* study this base was shown to deliver semaglutide into and through human gingival and oral tissues. In addition, this base was designed with permeation-enhancing and unique mucoadhesive properties to help drive medication into mucosal tissue.

Doses are easily adjustable and there are no shots and no needles. Also, taking smaller doses more frequently can reduce the difference between trough and peak drug levels, leading to a smoother titration and a smoother steady state concentration as compared to once weekly dosing.
