NYOA Pit Pass Rules-Pit Pass Holder Copy

Must have valid driver's license to apply for pit pass.

Must have a valid driver's license to operate pit vehicle.

Must have liability insurance on vehicle using the pit pass.

Fee for the pit pass is \$20.

Pit vehicle operation must be in a safe and controlled manor at all times. A maximum speed of 10 mph.

Pit Vehicle occupants are to only use manufacturer approved seats. Each occupant must have their own seat.

No Pit vehicles are allowed on the race course during a race and they cannot be used to aid racers during a race that have become disabled to then continue that race for a scored position.

Promoter will have the discretion to not issue passes or suspend use if they feel event terrain is not able to handle the increased traffic (examples: muddy conditions causing the ground to be torn up because of the use of pit vehicles or excessive dust causing visibility issues).

Alcohol consumption is strictly prohibited while operating a pit vehicle.

Pit vehicles may be used from the time gates open until 10:00pm.

Pit vehicles must remain a minimum of 25 feet from the track.

Pit vehicle rules will be enforced by Promoter and their staff and all NYOA officials.

Pit vehicles are not allowed in VENDOR ROW.

Any violation that results in the loss of a pit pass at any event will also mean no future pit passes will be issued for the remainder of that season.
