
HONDURAS

15-day: birding and nature tour









TRIP OVERVIEW

This 15-day private tour was prepared to search for target birds in different destinations in Honduras. From the highlands to the lowlands, we will have the best time birding and exploring the biodiversity of Honduras!!

Prepare your camera and binoculars.

Day 1. Meet & Greet at San Pedro Sula Airport (SAP). According to arrivals, we will have our first birding of the trip at La Soledad Reserve (a dry forest). But in case there is a delay with the flights, we will visit you in the morning of the next day.

Day 2. After breakfast, we will head to Marcala. On the way, we could stop for some birding or continue to the hotel and bird around. At night we will search owls.

Day 3. The whole morning will be spent at Reserva El Jilguero, a water production area, to search for highlands bird species. Then in the afternoon, we will move to La Esperanza for a cultural sightseeing visit to Azacualpa Valley and handmade ethnic fabric looms.

Day 4. An early birding at hotel trails. After breakfast, we will visit El Consejero private nature reserve and Bird Sanctuary. Then drive to Finca Mercedes a coffee farm.

Day 5. We will continue exploring Finca Mercedes and Montecillos Reserve, a protected area. Then time to move to the Yojoa Lake area, where we will spend three nights.

Day 6. Before breakfast, we will bird at the hotel trails, Cerro Azul National Park, a cloud forest. The rest of the day is dedicated to Luna del Puente, a charming private nature reserve, and a coffee and cacao farm awaits us for the artisanal Chocolate experience. Then had a blast birding at their trails and also at an open pine field.

Day 7. A boat tour to explore Lojoa Lake After lunch, explore one of the best places to see the Honduran Emerald, our only endemic bird at El Rancho.

Day 8. After breakfast, we will drive to Zamorano area, and visit Hacienda Santa Clara to add more *lifers*.





- **Day 9.** Time to explore Uyuca Biological Reserve all morning. Then transfer to our next destination, a rural/eastern part of the country, Olancho.
- **Day 10.** Finca Zari, awaits you to enjoy target birds. Very few internationals have been in this coffee farm. In the afternoon we will drive to Olanchito.
- **Day 11.** Because of the heat, we will start birding early in Arenal dry area and Colibri Esmeralda Reserve, named after our only endemic species. Then mid-morning we will drive to La Ceiba, home of Pico Bonito and the Lovely Cotinga. We will bird in the hotel garden.
- Day 12. Early morning time to explore other trails of Pico Bonito Lodge. After checkout, lunch, and then Casabe cultural experience right before entering Salado Barra at Cuero & Salado Wildlife Refuge. This place is a naturalist's dream with the possibility of sighting the subspecies of West Indian manatee: the Antillean manatee, American Crocodile, White-headed Capuchin & Mantled Howler Monkeys. Here we will have an enigmatic night boat birding tour through mangroves.
- Day 13. Before breakfast, we will have another time to explore at the day the aquatic trail. Then we will move to Tela, a coastal town, home of the largest botanical garden in Honduras. In the afternoon, we will explore the beautiful Lancetilla Botanical Garden.
- **Day 14.** One more chance to explore Lancetilla Botanical Garden. After lunch, we will continue to our final destination.

Day 15. Transfer to San Pedro Sula Airport (SAP)


