TLILIC2015 Licence to drive a medium rigid vehicle



This training program is designed for people who wish to attain a “Medium Rigid” Drivers licence.

Medium Rigid vehicles are trucks that have two axles and a Gross Vehicle Mass (GVM) over 8 tonnes with two axles, this class of licence is popular with delivery vehicles, small tip trucks or other medium sized commercial vehicle.

People seek this licence to upgrade their skills from a LR Licence to expand their career opportunities, or as part of a job role as a delivery driver, courier, bus driver or other commercial role.

A Medium Rigid 'Class MR' covers a rigid vehicle with 2 axles and a GVM of more than 8 tonnes. Any towed trailer must not weigh more than 9 tonnes GVM. This also includes vehicles in class 'LR'.

To enter into this course, you will need to:

- Already hold a “C” Manual class drivers licence and be off “Red P's”.
- You will need to have been to the Road Traffic Authority (RMS), passed the RMS “MR Knowledge Test”. (The RMS charge Fees for this. (See RMS pricing guide <https://www.rms.nsw.gov.au/roads/licence/fees.html>)
- Pass the RMS Eyesight test
- Been issued with a RMS CBA (Competency Based Assessment) Logbook and CBA guide book. (The RMS charge fees for this. (See RMS pricing guide <https://www.rms.nsw.gov.au/roads/licence/fees.html>)
- Contact Advanced Skills and book in for training and assessment please have your Logbook with you when you call, as there are details within the Logbook which we require for processing your booking.

During the Advanced Skills course you will learn to:

- Drive the Medium Rigid vehicle
- Monitor traffic and road conditions
- Monitor and maintain vehicle performance

These skills are delivered and assessed over a period of a minimum of 5 hours, plus a minimum of 45 minutes FCA, each driver learns at a different rate, and thus you may require a slightly more.

If extra time required, a further charge may be applied.

The assessment process consists of:

- You passing the assessment conducted by Advanced Skills
- Advanced Skills submitting your results to the RMS computer system
- You going to the RMS, and paying the Licence upgrade fee. (Please see RMS pricing guide <https://www.rms.nsw.gov.au/roads/licence/fees.html>)

The unit of competency is nationally recognised and can only be delivered by a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) that complies with the governing standards of quality control and quality training and assessment.

Assessment is based on competency i.e. your ability to answer a number of questions about driving, the road rules, the vehicle and then satisfactory driving the vehicle in normal traffic and performing the normal driving tasks such as:

- Braking to a line.
- Maintaining safe buffer zones.
- Selecting when to merge or enter a stream of traffic.

- Observation and use of mirrors.
- Selection of appropriate speed and vehicle position when turning.
- Co-ordination of gears, clutch, accelerator and other major controls.
- Correct signalling.
- Pre-departure check.

- Kerbside stop
