TLILIC3018 Licence to drive multi-combination vehicle



This training program is designed for people who wish to attain a “Multi Combination” Drivers licence. People seek this licence to upgrade their skills from a Multi-combination (HC) or a Heavy Rigid (HR) Licence. Please note that the NSW Transport Roads and Maritime Services require you to have held your HR or HC licence for over 12 months.

Multi Combination vehicles are also known as B Doubles, B Triples or Road Trains.

Multi Combination vehicles are also commonly equipped with two different types of gearboxes, these are:

- “Automatic/Synchromesh” such as an Eaton Gearbox, which is found to be more often fitted to European Trucks. Drivers with manual car license are more easily able to adapt to this style of gearbox.
- “Manual/Constant Mesh” gearboxes such as the “Roadranger” require the due of the gear changing technique known as “Double declutching” this is questionably more challenging to participants who have no prior experience with this style of gearbox. The use of the Roadranger is declining as more new European based trucks enter the market.

We can teach you either

Should you select the Automatic Gearbox option, you will receive a Class B licence endorsement which will only allow you to drive vehicles fitted with Automatic gearboxes.

To enter into this course, you will need to:

- Already hold a “HR or “HC” class drivers licence for over 12 months.
- You will need to have been to the Road Traffic Authority (RMS), passed the RMS “MC Knowledge Test”. (See RMS pricing guide <https://www.rms.nsw.gov.au/roads/licence/fees.html>)
- Pass the RMS Eyesight and a medical (by a medical practitioner), test
- Been issued with a RMS CBA (Competency Based Assessment) Logbook and CBA guide book. (See RMS pricing guide <https://www.rms.nsw.gov.au/roads/licence/fees.html>)
- Contact Advanced Skills and book in for training and assessment please have your Logbook with you when you call, as there are details within the Logbook which we require for processing your booking.

During the course you will learn to:

- Drive the Multi Combination vehicle
- Monitor traffic and road conditions
- Monitor and maintain vehicle performance

Drivers will be required to complete a minimum of 8 hours allocated to training and assessment, plus a minimum of 45 minutes FCA, each driver learns at a different rate, and thus you may require a slightly more.

If extra time required, a further charge may be applied.

The assessment process consists of:

- You passing the assessment conducted by Advanced Skills
- Advanced Skills submitting your results to the RMS computer system
- You going to the RMS, and paying the Licence upgrade fee. (Please see RMS pricing guide <https://www.rms.nsw.gov.au/roads/licence/fees.html>)

The unit of competency is nationally recognised and can only be delivered by a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) that complies with the governing standards of quality control and quality training and assessment.

Assessment is based on competency i.e. your ability to answer a number of questions about driving, the road rules, the vehicle and then satisfactory driving the vehicle in normal traffic and performing the normal driving tasks such as long reverse.

Due to the requirements of maintaining a safe learning environment, Advanced Skills reserves the right to withdraw any participant(s) on the grounds of safety.

Advanced Skills is flexible in the format and timing of learning and assessment activities to ensure that we provide every opportunity for participants to demonstrate their skills and abilities. Fees and Charges: •

- Cost: \$1,300, minimum of 8 hour course (Auto/Synchromesh). Typically two blocks totally a minimum of 8 hours for assessment plus a minimum of 45 minutes for FCA.
- Cost: \$2,000, minimum of 8 hours course (Manual/Constant mesh). Typically two blocks totally a minimum of 8 hours for assessment plus a minimum of 45 minutes for FCA.
- Additional charges: Should the client require more hours to complete the course this will attract an additional charge.
- As this training is Nationally Accredited, it does not attract GST.

Our Fee and Refund policy is:

- \$600 fee is charged when booking and training/assessment dates set.
- An additional \$700 is charged at the commencement of the training day if undertaking the Auto/Synchromesh gearbox or
- An additional \$900 is charged at the commencement of the training day if undertaking the manual or constant mesh gearbox with a final payment of \$500 is to be paid prior to assessment.
- Course cancellation or shifting of course dates with 3 days or less will incur a \$200 fee. This will be deducted from any refund due to the participant if cancelling, or will need to be paid by the participant if shifting courses.
- Course cancellation or shifting of course dates of greater than 3 days will allow a 100% refund of course fees

For emergency situations it will be up to the discretion of the business manager and instructor/assessor at time to charge any fees.
