Other Issues with After School Programming in Bushwick

- Lack of time and resources for schools to apply to grants or develop relationship with CBOs (ex. Grant writers)
- Few CBOs in the community with enough resources to
- Lack of interest from city or state in expanding or funding this programming
- Very expensive, time consuming to run an in-school program with teachers.

Funding Streams

- Government
 - City
- DYCD -Department of Youth & Community Development (funding per child, 3K per child)
 - Compass elementary, middle and high school
 - SONYC (School's Out NYC)- middle school
- OASP NYC Department of Education, Office of Arts & Special Projects (only two years, 15K)
- CASA funding (discretionary funding from Council Members, only 20K)
- State (1,600 per child per year and less support)
 - Empire
 - Advantage After School Programs (NY state Office of Children and Families)
- Federal
- 21st Century Community Learning Centers from TANF)
- Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF)
- Private Grants & Foundations
 - Several (Example: Disney Grant at PS 116).

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Prioritize and continue funding existing after school programs
- Approve and fund "Universal After School Program" bill in City Council
- Fully fund schools, including owed funding from Foundation Formula so schools can develop in-schools programs.
- Allocate funding directly to schools not only to CBOs
- Allow students to participate to afterschool programs from other schools, districts and even private programs (vouchers)
- Create an Office at DOE dedicated exclusively to oversee this.
- During Covid-19, ensure students have access online-based afterschool programming, including arts & crafts, body movement, etc.
- When Covid-19 resumes, immediately reinstate funding for DYCD and other programs.
