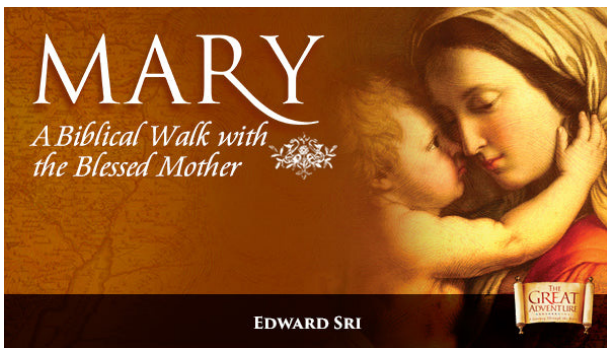

Those seeking Sacramental Marriage should contact the parish 1 year in advance.
