THE PHILLIPS FAST: It is never too late to begin fasting! If you have found it difficult or maybe have forgotten to take on a fasting regimen, then consider fasting from meat the week before Christmas and offer a few more prayers, and a few more alms.

MYSTERY OF REPENTANCE AND THE FAST: Catholics are required to confess grave or mortal sins at least once a year, and should also not approach the Eucharist in the state of mortal sin. However, monthly confession is suggested even for those who only have venial sins. The Church suggests that fasting periods are an appropriate time to repent and ask for

forgiveness so that the anticipated Feast can be solemnly celebrated and that all may receive the Eucharist. Booklets are available for free so that all can make a proper examination of conscience to discern whether or not serious sins have been committed.

Saint Paul tell us in his first letter to the Corinthians, "Whoever, therefore, eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of profaning the body and blood of the Lord. Let a man examine himself, and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For any one who eats and drinks **without discerning the body** eats and drinks judgment upon himself." (1Cor. 11:27-29)
