EVAGRIOS THE SOLITARY (345-399AD): ON PRAYER excerpts from the Philokalia, Vol. 1

- 18. If you wish to pray as you should, deny yourself all the time, and when any kind of affliction troubles you, meditate on prayer.
- 21. 'Leave your gift before the altar; first go away and be reconciled with your brother' (Matt. 5:24), and when you return you will pray without disturbance. For rancour darkens the intellect of one who prays, and extinguishes the light of his prayers.

If one is following the traditional fast of no meat or dairy for the entirely of Lent, then these are the days in which we have our last meat, and our last dairy. We will be having potluck luncheons after both Divine Liturgies. On Cheesefare Sunday, we will also stay to celebrate Forgiveness Vespers of Cheesefare Sunday. This will really be the transition into the Great Fast which begins on Clean Monday, March 4th.
