END OF THE PHILLIPS FAST: We have come to the end of our time of fasting and preparation for the Nativity of Jesus Christ. Christmas Eve day, **Dec. 24th**, **is traditionally a day of strict abstinence** (no meat or dairy), but is not required under the current law of the Metropolia. One may take-on this fasting in any capacity and are encouraged to do so. Likewise, this **Friday**, **Dec. 27**, **is NOT a day of fasting**. One may eat meat without alternate penance.

not yet received one, there are some available in the narthex. So far, 13 families have donated a total of \$2350 towards our goal of \$10,800.
