A Note About Scheduled Liturgy Attendance:

Masks are now **REQUIRED** for attendance at the weekend Divine Liturgies. Also, it has been suggested that we move to a Ticketing System for weekend attendance. This would mean that each family would have to sign up for a ticket each week. This will allow some flexibility, so please let Fr. Lewis know if this would be beneficial for your family.

The Mysteries (Sacraments) of the Church are available for all Baptized Catholics in Good Standing. This means that a Catholic attends Divine Liturgy on Sundays and Holydays of Obligation, utilizes the Mystery of Repentance at least once a year, receives the Eucharist at least once a year, observes the church's penitential seasons and fasting regulations to include abstaining from meat or an equivalent penance on all Fridays except when mitigated, supports the Church in Her temporal needs through offering of time, talent, and treasure, and believes the Church's teachings on faith and morals.
