On the Dispensation of Obligation: Bishop Kurt stated in his letter of May 13, which is posted on our website: "Should I stay home from church, even though the church is open? In his chapter on the Holy Eucharist, St. Paul says, 'Let each one examine himself.' If you think you are contagious, or if you think you are in danger, you are dispensed from any obligations to attend. Please stay home if you do not feel well." This means that we have returned to our "normal" dispensations of attending holydays of obligation. Those who are vulnerable or who are sick are still dispensed from their obligation, but all others are encouraged to resume attendance.

BEGINNING OF THE DORMITION FAST: The Dormition Fast will begin this Saturday, Aug. 1. It is not required by church law to participate in this fast, but it is a traditional practice. The Feast of the Dormition of the Theotokos (Assumption) is a holyday of obligation and one of great importance in the life of the Church. It is traditional to fast from all meat and dairy during this time, but one may add any additional fasting they desire. We will gloriously celebrate this feast with a Liturgical All-Night Vigil and an actual All-Night Vigil from August 14-15 with the celebration of the Divine Liturgy in the morning. A SignUpGenious will be forwarded later for those who would like to pray and keep vigil during the night of Aug. 14th.
