2020 ANNUAL BISHOP'S APPEAL: Our parish goal is the same as last year at \$10,800. MATERNITY OF THE HOLY ANNA: This Solemn Feastday is celebrated on December 8 and is known in the Western Church as the Immaculate Conception. This feast celebrates the Conception of the Most Holy Theotokos in the womb of Saint Anna. In 1854, Pope Pius IX pronounced and defined that the Blessed Virgin Mary "in the first instance of her conception, by a singular privilege and grace granted by God, in view of the merits of Jesus Christ, the Saviour of the human race, was preserved exempt from all stain of original sin." Mary is hailed by the Archangel Gabriel as "Full of Grace", meaning that she is full of God's Grace, and therefore, could not have been subject to the sin of Adam and Eve.
