HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION SOON: The glorious feast of the Ascension of Our Lord, God, and Savior Jesus Christ is on Thursday, May 26. This is a Holy Day of Obligation, which means that if one does not attend the Divine Liturgy or another Catholic Eucharistic Liturgy (Mass, or other), then one would need to confess this as a Grave (mortal) sin, before one next receives the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. This feast celebrates the Risen Jesus ascending bodily into heaven, as He instructs the Apostles to wait for the reception of the Holy Spirit, so that they will be able to correctly guide The Church through the centuries. To allow the faithful to fulfill their obligation, we will have Divine Liturgy at Noon, and 6:30PM.
