The Mysteries (Sacraments) of the Church are available for all Baptized Catholics in Good Standing. This means that a Catholic attends

Divine Liturgy on Sundays and Holydays of Obligation, utilizes the Mystery of Repentance at least once a year, receives the Eucharist at least once a year, observes the church's penitential seasons and fasting regulations to include abstaining from meat or an equivalent penance on all Fridays except when mitigated, supports the Church in Her temporal needs through offering of time, talent, and treasure, and believes the Church's teachings on faith and morals.

PENTECOST SUNDAY PICNIC & VESPERS: Our monthly picnic will be on Pentecost Sunday, June 4. Italian sausage and peppers, chicken penne Alfredo, and rigatoni and meatballs will be provided. Others are asked to bring salads, sub (hoagie) rolls, charcuterie items, fresh mozzarella salad, and desserts, and some drinks. All will be invited to stay and participate in the beautiful Kneeling Vespers, where we solemnly return to singing and praying the Prayer to the Holy Spirit, "Heavenly King, Comforter."

PRAYER CHANGE AT PENTECOST: We may now resume the prayers "Glory to You, Our God..." and the prayer to the Holy Spirit, "Heavenly King, Comforter..." in our usual daily prayers; thank you Holy Spirit for your help, comfort, and guidance!

THE APOSTLES FAST: After we celebrate Pentecost Week, we may then enter into a voluntary period of fasting which leads up to the Holy Day of Obligation that is Saints Peter & Paul on June 29. One may apply any severity of fasting one chooses, but the traditional prescriptions are a strict fast (no meat or dairy) on Monday, Wednesday, & Friday with mitigations of wine and oil on Tuesdays and Thursdays. As with all fasting periods, there are Days of Alleluia, days on which the Divine Liturgy is not to be celebrated; we will adhere to this prescription, so please check the bulletin for days and times of services. The voluntary fast will end on June 28.

SAVE THE DATE FOR A FLOAT DOWN THE RIVER:
