- Introduction to the Divine Liturgy (covers pages 11-103 of the Divine Liturgies book)
- The Liturgical Year (covers pages 242-357)
- Hierarchical Services and Reader Services (includes ordination services, small Hours, and Typika)

Taking the classes "for credit" means you can get feedback on your singing and access to all the learning tools for each class.
