PAVILION PROJECT UPDATE: The Pavilion plans have been finalized and we are now waiting for two more approvals for the project from engineers. We expect this step of the process to be completed within two months. We will then be issued the appropriate permits, and submit to the Eparchy of Passaic for approval, and we will be able to begin construction. Upon issuance of the permits, we will then submit to the parish an updated estimate of the project cost and a current balance sheet. There may be other landscaping projects to be completed at the same time, we will keep you informed as these details are finalized.
