PAVILION PROJECT UPDATE: *Our architect has secured engineers for our project, and has given us an estimate of 1-2 weeks for them to complete their work. After they have reviewed the plans, made adjustments, and affixed their appropriate stamps, our architect will then resubmit the plans to Roswell. Roswell usually takes 1-2 weeks to review, and we should then be supplied with the appropriate permits. When we receive the permits, they will be submitted to the Eparchy of Passaic for approval, and we will then be able to begin construction.* Upon issuance of the permits, we will then submit to the parish an updated estimate of the project cost and a current balance sheet. There may be other landscaping projects to be completed at the same time, we will keep you informed as these details are finalized.
