The Mysteries (Sacraments) of the Church are available for all Baptized Catholics in Good Standing. This means that a Catholic attends Divine Liturgy on Sundays and Holydays of Obligation, utilizes the Mystery of Repentance at least once a year, receives the Eucharist at least once a year, observes the church's penitential seasons and fasting regulations to include abstaining from meat or an equivalent penance on all Fridays except when mitigated, supports the Church in Her temporal needs through offering of time, talent, and treasure, and believes the Church's teachings on faith and morals.

PAVILION PROJECT UPDATE: *Our architect has secured engineers for our project, and has given us an estimate of 1 week (still have not heard back yet, but this was within the estimated time-frame) for them to complete their work. After they have reviewed the plans, made adjustments, and affixed their appropriate stamps, our architect will then resubmit the plans to Roswell. Roswell usually takes 1-2 weeks to review, and we should then be supplied with the appropriate permits. When we receive the permits, they will be submitted to the Eparchy of Passaic for approval, and we will then be able to begin construction.* Upon issuance of the permits, we will then submit to the parish an updated estimate of the project cost and a current balance sheet. There may be other landscaping projects to be completed at the same time, we will keep you informed as these details are finalized.
