The first, the Bethany Ministry, provides aid to those in need because they are sick, home bound or struggling financially; to provide food, drink or just to sit and have a chat. Similarly, the Lazarus Ministry provides comfort & prayer to those grieving. Volunteers in Lazarus may also provide practical assistance such as preparing meals, helping coordinate with the pastor & funeral home, or simply running errands.
