Apostles Fast: The Peter & Paul Fast begins Sunday evening (5/26) and lasts until June 28. The Typikon prescribes strict abstinence (no meat or diary) on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, with a mitigation (wine and oil) on Tuesdays and Thrusdays. The Ruthenian Metropolia has identified this period as a pentitential season. This fast is not necessary to engage with under pain of sin, but may be observed voluntarily.

*Father's Day Float Down The River: Following last year's success, we will again have our June picnic on the Saturday before Father's Day at Gina & Ken's in Ellijay. This means that the Saturday Evening Divine Liturgy will be at the picnic, and there will be no services at the church that day. Rain Date is Saturday, June 22. Why Do Byzantines Do That?
