FATHERS DAY RIVER FLOAT LITURGY: The Saturday June 20 evening liturgy will take place after the River Float. **There will be no liturgy at the church,** so please plan accordingly.

OFFICE OF HOLY OIL: We will once again join the other Atlanta Eastern Catholic Parishes for the joint Office of Holy Oil here at Epiphany on Friday, June 26 at 7PM.

LITURGY INTENTIONS: All those who need to request liturgy intentions are encouraged to do so. You can drop off your stipend and intention request at the office, or talk to Father Lewis.

APOSTLES FAST: The Apostles Fast began the evening of May 31st, and lasts until June 28th. It is not as strict as the Great Fast. The Typicon prescribes strict abstinence (no meat or dairy) on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, with a mitigation (wine and oil) on Tuesdays and Thursdays. The Ruthenian Metropolia has identified this period as a penitential season. This fast is not necessary to engage with under pain of sin, but may be observed voluntarily.

ADULT EDUCATION CLASS IN JUNE ON ST.

FRANCIS: Daniel Synosky will present the following topics on the Sundays of June:

- 1) Who St. Francis is NOT: debunking the myth and discovering the real person and saint
- 2) The Spiritual Life of St. Francis and the Franciscan Spirituality
- 3) Intersections with the East: Comparison of Francis to the Fathers and to the East
- 4) The San Damiano Cross: the icon that became the “Franciscan Cross” is really a spiritually rich icon originating from the Syriac tradition and holding in its details a comprehensive treatise on Francis and the Spiritual Life in a very Eastern medium - the icon!

ORIENTALE LUMEN XXX CONFERENCE

ANNOUNCED: The 30th Orientale Lumen Conference will take place on July 13-15 at the St. John Paul II Shrine and Retreat House in Washington, DC. The theme will be “Ecumenical Crossroad: Consensus Achieved – What’s Next?” Speakers will include Cardinal Sean O’Malley, Archbishop Flavio Pace from the Vatican, Bishop John Michael Botean (Romanian Greek Catholic), Bishop Anthony Vrame (Greek Orthodox), and Lector Jack Figel, Founder of the Conferences. The new papal nuncio, Archbishop Gabriele Caccia, and Metropolitan Tikhon, primate of the Orthodox Church in America, will attend some sessions. Video lectures will also be shown by Archbishop Borys Gudziak (Ukrainian Greek Catholic), Metropolitan Job of Pisidia (Ecumenical Patriarchate) and Archimandrite Cyril Hovorun (Orthodox Church of Ukraine). The Mysteries (Sacraments) of the Church are available for all Baptized Catholics in Good Standing. This means that a Catholic attends Divine Liturgy on Sundays and Holydays of Obligation, utilizes the Mystery of Repentance at least once a year, receives the Eucharist at least once a year, observes the church’s penitential seasons and fasting regulations to include abstaining from meat or an equivalent penance on all Fridays except when mitigated, supports the Church in her temporal needs through offering of time, talent, and treasure, and believes the Church’s teachings on faith and morals. Those seeking Sacramental Marriage should contact the parish 1 year in advance.

FLOAT DOWN THE RIVER FOR FATHER'S DAY: A whole day of fun!!! Celebrate Father's Day with a Float Down the Cartecay River and enjoy a day of picnicking ending with the Saturday evening Divine Liturgy at Gina & Ken's in Ellijay on June 20 with a rain date of August 1. **This Saturday evening liturgy WILL replace our usual Saturday evening liturgy** on this day, so please plan appropriately.

General Info: The community is gated and you will need the access code #1015 to enter. One can float on the river before or after lunch. There will be activities for children that can't float on the river at the house. We will be serving BBQ, but **bringing a covered dish is strongly encouraged**. If you would like alcohol or beer, please BYOB. Water, lemonade and ice tea will be provided. We will have last call for food around 4PM to allow a 1hour fast before Divine Liturgy at 5:00PM.

There will be two groups floating ("waves") please read the details for both below to determine which one will work best for your family.

WAVE ONE: 12:30PM

- Arrive at 12:00 to drop off food you bring and get ready to get in the water.
- Float down the river (approx. 1.5 hrs.)

WAVE TWO: 2:30PM

- Arrive between 12:00pm-2:00pm
- Float down the river at 2:30pm (approx. 1.5 hrs.)
- **ENDPOINT** - get out just after the bridge.
