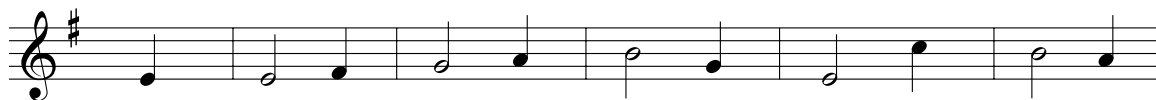




## ORDINARY SUNDAY IN TONE 8

### Troparion of the Resurrection - *Tone 8*




You de-scend-ed from on high, O mer-ci-ful One. You ac-cept-ed

### Kontakion of the Resurrection - *Tone 8*



Ris-ing from the grave, you raised the dead. You lift-ed up Ad-am,

resurrec-tion from the dead, O Most Mer-ci-ful One.

**Prokeimenon** (Psalm 75:12,2)



Make vows to the Lord your God, to the Lord your God and ful-fill them,
