2025 ANNUAL BISHOPS APPEAL: The Eparchy of Passaic's annual appeal has begun. Our goal is the same as the last few years, \$10,800. If we reach our goal by June 1 2026, we will receive a 40% rebate. We have met this goal 5 years running, so giving to the Bishop's Appeal is giving to our parish! Anyone who has not received an envelope in the mail for the Bishop's Appeal that would like one can pick one up in the narthex on the shelf next to the office door. So far 9 families have donated a total of \$3,000!

This will help us store all of our decorations, lawn care equipment, and tools so we can declutter the narthex and choir loft!
