MARRIAGE JUBILEE: Father Lewis will be flying to Orlando, FL on Friday to attend the Southern Syncellate Marriage Jubilee Liturgy. The Liturgy is on Saturday the 17th, and Father Lewis will be returning late that same evening. The Saturday vigil liturgy at Epiphany will be replaced with the deacon-led Typica Eucharistic Service, so there will be no confessions Saturday night. Sunday morning Liturgy will proceed as usual.

Those seeking Sacramental Marriage should contact the parish 1 year in advance.
