We will be holding our own Pysanky Workshop here at Epiphany from 10AM-4PM on Saturday, February 28. At this class, you will be able to learn the traditional symbols and techniques used to produce these works of art. Those seeking Sacramental Marriage should contact the parish 1 year in advance.
