Valley Academy 6-8th Grade Dress Code (Approved by Board Vote 12/13/18)

Bottoms - In addition to khaki and navy pants – students can wear dark, solid-colored pants or denim jeans. The jeans must not have holes or rips. Shorts must be no shorter than 4 inches above the knees in length. Leggings are ok if worn as an undergarment.

Tops - any sleeved shirt that does not have pictures, large logos (except the school logo), or words. No midriffs or altered shirts.

Shoes - Shoes must have a closed toe and back. Acceptable colors for shoes are: blue, black, white, brown, or grey (or any configuration of those colors on the same shoe). Flip-flops and sandals are not permitted. Flashing lights, glitter, fur-like material and wheels are not allowed on shoes worn during the school day or school sponsored event.

Valley Academy administration reserves the right to be the ultimate authority in deciding what constitutes appropriate school attire.
