The gain control on the M-216 transmitter allows the user to adjust the sensitivity of the microphone. The HH-185 boom incorporates a unique integral antenna design so that no external antenna is required while still maintaining the maximum transmission range.





The HH-185 can also be used with the PR-216 Option P receiver as a handheld, "point-to-sound source" type device to add functionality to the AT-216 assistive listening system.
