Culture Tip of the Month

- **Careful watering this month.** This often means no watering at all. Water only when truly necessary.
- **Space plants amply.** Good air circulation is essential across the coming months.
- **A disease prevention program** should be started this month.
- **Clean up growing area and plants.** Remove dead leaves from plants and the ground. Prune trees and shrubs to increase light and air circulation.
- **Apply snail bait** lightly early in the month and again lightly mid-month.
