Tasks for December

December Climate Data

Average high: 77.5
Average low: 62.2
Average mean: 69.9
Average rainfall: 2.18"



- 1. Water judiciously early in the day so plants have as many hours as possible to dry and allow longer intervals between watering to dry plants thoroughly.
- 2. Reduce fertilizer as most sympodial orchids are resting in December. Provide extra potassium and magnesium. Biweekly or even monthly applications of a balanced fertilizer or 15-515 are still desirable.
- 4. Segregate dormant genera in bright dry area.
- 5. Keep those vandas, phalaenopsis and hard cane dendrobiums as warm as you can.

<u>Epiphytic orchids</u> - grow on other plants using the host plant as anchorage



<u>Terrestrial orchids</u>- grow in the ground, in soil or leaf litter

<u>Lithophytic orchids</u>- grow on rocks



<u>Bilaterally symmetrical flowers</u> - each side mirrors the other



Pollinia - clumps of pollen



<u>Lip</u> - the modified bottom petal of an orchid, usually showy to attract pollinators
