#### PSLOS ANNUAL ORCHID AUCTION

(No Noon Class)



The Port St. Lucie Orchid Society's Annual Orchid Auction RETURNS! The purpose of the auction is to provide members with an outlet in managing the number of plants in their own collections, to provide the orchid loving public with an opportunity to purchase quality plants at fair prices, and to further our mission to add to the ranks of orchid addicts.

11:00 a.m. — Doors will open for members who are bringing orchids to be auctioned. No plants will be accepted for sale after 12:30 p.m. SELLERS, PLEASE BE PROMPT!

12:30 p.m. — Doors will open for buyer viewing of the orchids being auctioned.

1:00 p.m. — The auction will begin and goes until finished. There are no planned breaks.

BUYERS: THERE IS NO EARLY CHECKOUT. YOU NEED TO BE ABLE TO STAY UNTIL THE END AS IT IS TOO DISRUPTIVE IF WE ALLOW EARLY CHECKOUTS. THANK YOU FOR YOUR UNDERSTANDING.

#### The rules are as follows:

- 1. Only society members may offer plants for sale, but ALL buyers are welcome.
- 2. Members are limited to 20 plants for sale. For every 10 plants that you bring to sell, one is donated to the Society's table.
- 3. The auction is designed to help members manage their collections. It is not meant to be an outlet for commercial or quasi-commercial sales.
- 4. Plants for sale must be brought to the auction no later than 30 minutes prior to the auction. There is paperwork for the seller to fill out on each plant. If there is a minimum bid, a label must be put on a leaf (labels will be provided at sign-in). Plants brought after that time will not be considered.
- 5. 10% of all sales will go to the society. Checks to sellers will be provided within 30 days of the auction.
- 6. Plants will be auctioned at random. We alternate between sellers.
- 7. Each plant will be auctioned individually. The auctioneer will not sell one plant and then several more of the same plant for the same price without bidding.
- 8. If a seller's plants are not all auctioned off, further sales may be conducted independent of the auction AFTER all sales have been tallied and may not occur within the auction building. (Or you can choose to donate them to the garden's orchid room.)
- 9. ONLY THE AUCTIONEER and/or assistant (not bidders) will determine the last bid by saying "sold."
- 10. ALL SALES ARE FINAL. We take cash, check, or charge. THERE IS NO EARLY CHECKOUT.

Hi everyone!

What a GREAT meeting/shower we had! I was amazed by our member's generosity and what fun it was to watch Ti and Henry open their gifts!

So, here's this month's report. Our current balance is \$12,122.87. We paid our annual liability and Directors and Officers insurance which was \$1,365.85. We also paid the quarterly FL state sales tax of \$16.42. Florida Orchid House did not charge us for their presentation, but we did pay them \$100.00 for our raffle orchids. We spent \$37.44 on orchids and supplies for our orchid garden, \$104.00 for monthly storage, and \$100 donation to Smile Train in memory of Jackie Lawson.

Our income included \$1,055.00 for the November 1 bus trip, \$206.00 in raffle sales (net profit \$106.00) and membership \$40.00.




#### **PRUNING ORCHIDS**

You need to prune an orchid:

- 1. To keep it healthy. Look the plant over to spot any issues while they are still minor and fixable.
- 2. To remove diseased or dead tissue.
- 3. To get your orchid to rebloom. Prune spikes when the blooms have faded and fallen; spikes are no longer green. Beneath the base of a spike, nodes are located. They are where potential new blooms form.

#### Tasks for October

Fall Climate Data
Average high: 89.0
Average low: 75.7
Average mean: 82.4
Average rainfall: 8.38"



- Careful watering this month often means no watering at all. Water only when truly necessary.
- Space plants amply. Good air circulation is essential across the coming months.
- Re-pot Phals and reset Vandas. Make sure that plants are firmly set in their new abodes.
- Begin or continue a disease prevention program.
- Clean up growing area and plants. Remove dead leaves from plants and the ground. Prune trees and shrubs to increase light and air circulation.
- Apply snail bait lightly early in the month and again lightly mid-month.
