BY-LAWS Updated AGM 2015

- 1. The Annual General Meeting shall be held in November each year to elect the Executive Committee
- 2. The Sub Committee can consist of Vice President, Weigh-in Master, Vice Weigh-in Master, , Publicity Officer, If the Executive Committee deems a sub-committee member inactive, he or she may be replaced.
- 3. Fees shall become due by the 30^{th of} September each year
- 4. The Club shall be dissolved in the event of membership being less than 3 three persons. Any assets or monies on hand (should the club be dissolved) and after payment of all expenses and liabilities, shall be handed over to the Volunteer Marine Rescue Hervey Bay Inc
- 5. Social events must be available to all members. The costs of these may be met by members participating or may be subsidised partly or fully by the club
- 6. Club members must contact the Social Co-Ordinator by the due date to be considered for same
- 7. Club Competitions shall close at the end of September each year
- 8. Presentation Night will be held in November each year, and must

be financial for the current year to attend.

- 9. The Club does not accept any responsibilities for any member or their visitor or their gear whilst on any fishing trip or any club activity
- 10. The Club Weigh-in Master, if unavailable to attend any outing may appoint a Trip Weigh-in Master for that outing
- 11. Any member found contravening Club By-Laws shall lose all points accrued for the year.
- 12. New member nominations forms must be handed to the secretary for approval at the next committee meeting.
- 13. New members joining the club on or after 30th September shall be deemed financial to the end of the financial year
- 14. Yearly Trophies to be Awarded to senior mem, senior women, overall junior, and all divisions.
 - 15. Honorary Membership may be offered to persons of some status in the Community who have rendered valuable service or Support to the Hervey Bay Amateur Fishing Club Inc. membership to be approved at AGM, Th enlist will remain selective and always remain a small ratio of ordinary members.
 - 16. Life Membership may be offered on a select basis to members who have rendered particularly valuable and continuous service or support to H.B.A.F.C. Inc. with the length of service of a period of 7 years. Awarding Life Membership to be limited to one life member every two years and will confer voting rights. Written nominations must be presented in a sealed envelope to the Executive Committee and be approved at the AGM. Awards to be presented at the Presentation Night.
