As they headed home under the rainbow's glow, Thumper said with a giggle,

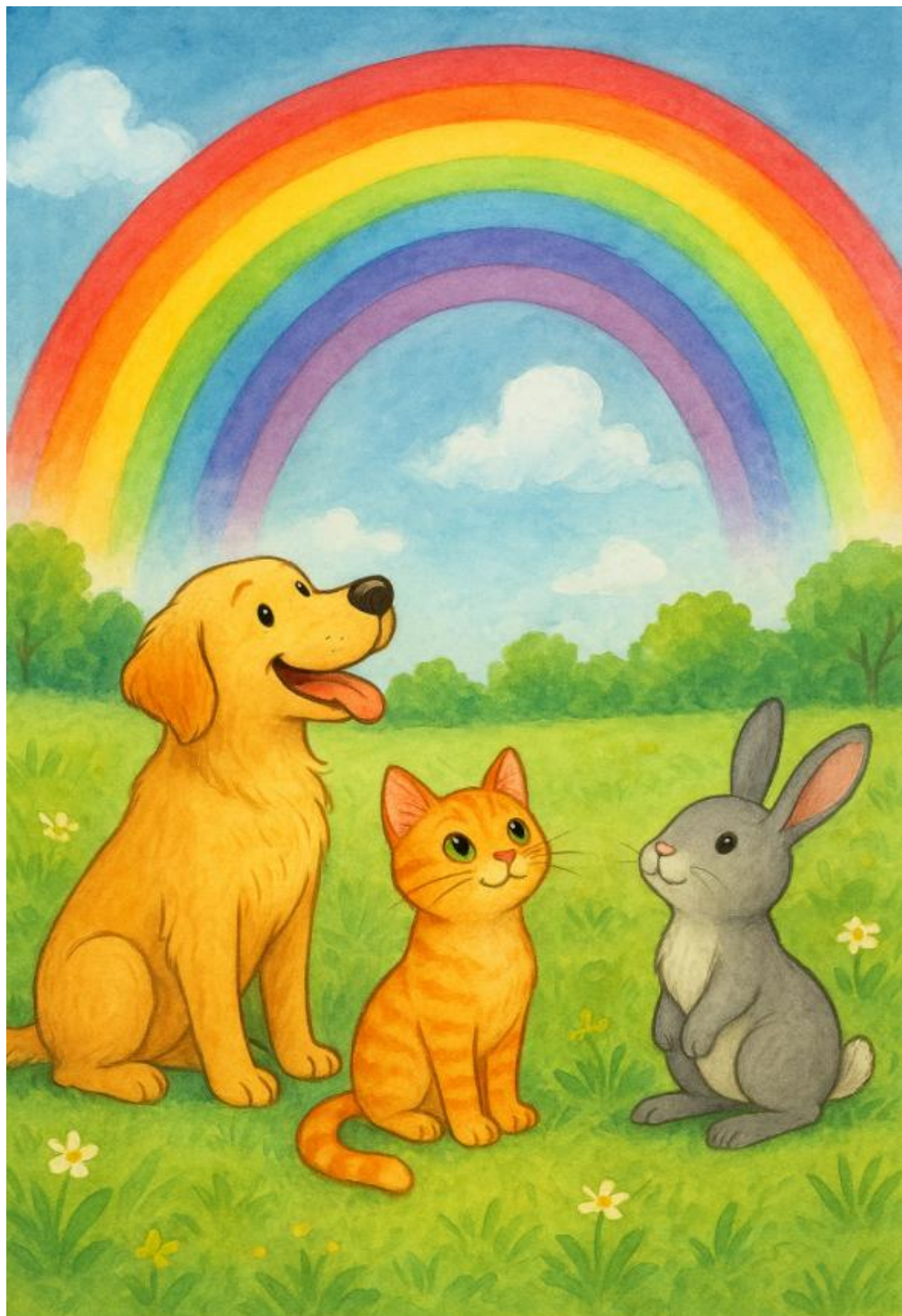
“Well... maybe next time the treasure will be carrots!”
