RULES

All puppies & veterans entered must be entered in a regular/non-regular class. Entries may be shown by anyone in good standing with the AKC.

Entries must be marked "Sweepstakes" with age division noted in space for additional classes.

Sweepstake Fees are in addition to the regular/non-regular class fee(s).

CLASS BREAKDOWN

(Each Division will be for Dogs and Bitches)

Puppy 6 Mos & Under 9 Mos.
Puppy 9 Mos & Under 12 Mos.
12 Mos & under 18 Mos.

Veteran Dog & Bitch – 7 Years – Under 9 Years
Veteran Dog & Bitch – 9 Years +
(Veterans may be Spayed or Neutered)

Sweepstakes – Cash Prizes

The stakes will be divided as follows:

Best of Sweepstakes – 50% in entry fees (Sweeps)
Best of Opposite – 25% of entry fees (Sweeps)
The balance to be retained by the Club for expenses

BEST OF THE BEST SPECTACULAR

Best of the Best in Independent and Regional Specialties

The Best of Breed winner at each Independent or Regional specialty is eligible to compete, therefore a breed may have multiple winners in the final Best of the Best competition. A spayed or neutered dog or bitch that wins its independent or regional specialty will be eligible to compete as the Best of Breed winner from that specialty. There may be no substitution of dogs in this competition. This competition will be held after all breed competitions are completed on Sunday.

ENTRY FEES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

Bernese Mountain Dog Club of Alaska shall assume the responsibility of collecting all recording and event service fees for The American Kennel Club. A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog in Conformation and an AKC Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry (not per dog) required for each recordable single entry class for each day at any Licensed or Member Club show. (Do NOT include these fees with your entry fees. They are already included in the entry fee.)

ENTRY FEES:

FIRST entry of each dog to include Best of Breed is \$35.00. Each additional entry of same dog is \$25.00.

ENTRY FEE for non-regular classes with one dog including Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes \$25.00 each.

ENTRY FEE for Junior Showmanship is \$10.00, or as an additional entry is \$5.00. (When a dog is entered in more than one class, the highest priced class is considered the first entry)

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES is 8:00 PM., Wednesday, July 22, 2026, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or changed, "except as provided for in Chapter 14, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules." Entries cannot be accepted by telephone, fax or telegram or conditional, unsigned or incomplete.

MAIL ALL ENTRIES WITH FEES TO: Sandy Smith, P.O. Box 870183, Wasilla, AK 99687-0183. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as possible after entries have closed. Should acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Event Secretary at the above address or by telephone (907) 715-9693.

NOTE: Make all checks and money orders payable to: Bernese Mountain Dog Club of Alaska. (BMDC of AK.) NSF or returned checks require cash payment of entry fee plus a \$25.00 NSF fee and any bank fees. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY BASIS.**

NOTE: Any entries mailed which will require a signature **WILL NOT** be accepted. USPS, Fed Ex, DHL and USPO overnight will be declined if waiver for signature is not authorized to allow package to be left. (No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition on its acceptance).

ENTRY FEES will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the Show Committee or because it has been entered incorrectly. If, because of riots, civil disturbance, extreme or dangerous weather, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open, or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

CHANGES OR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION must be received in writing or telephone prior to the closing of entries as published in the premium list.

Exhibitor set up (grooming spaces) will be allowed from 2:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.
There will be NO GROOMING set-up allowed before the show set-up is complete.

Power is available. No personal generators will be allowed inside the building.

Exhibitors & Handlers are required to keep their dogs under control at all times, restrained & kept away from all shrubbery, flowers & lawns except in designated areas.

EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and setup areas.

THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules are allowed on the show grounds.

AN EXERCISE AREA will be provided. Exhibitors must clean up after their own dog. Failure to use designated area or to clean up could result in action by the Event Committee.

DOGS SHOULD BE PRESENT IN AMPLE TIME before their scheduled judging time and they may be removed as soon as they are no longer needed for competition. Once brought onto the show grounds, a dog entered in this show may not be withheld from competition unless excused in writing by a Judge, Veterinarian, the Show Committee or the Event Secretary.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT for any dog holding up a class. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance to the judging ring when the class is scheduled to be judged. Owners or handlers of the dogs are solely responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

IT IS NOT THE RESPONSIBILITY of the Ring Steward to locate any dog, its owner or handler when the dog's presence is needed in the show ring.

Junior Showmanship Competition

Section 5. Classes and Divisions. The Junior Showmanship Classes shall be:

(A) Novice.

This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

(B) Open.

This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present. The winner of a Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the third (3rd) first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in the Open Class.

(C) Master. This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Best Junior Handler. The Junior Handler placed first in each of the regular Junior Showmanship Classes, if undefeated in any other Junior Showmanship Class at that show, shall automatically be eligible to compete for this

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
