ECB DBS and Safeguarding Training – Important Information for Club Volunteers

A full list of volunteer roles that require an ECB Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) and Safeguarding training can be found [here](#).

The ECB does not accept DBS checks transferred from other organisations and require all individuals in regulated roles to hold an ECB-issued DBS check.

If you are a volunteer, the service is free. To initiate an application please send your full name, date of birth and email address to your Club Safeguarding Officer.

DBS checks are required to be renewed annually which can be done via the DBS Update Service as long as you subscribe to it. You can log into your ECB DBS account to check when your renewal is due and see if you are already signed up to the update service.

Failure to complete an annual renewal will result in your DBS being invalid. To prevent this, please ensure you:

- Respond promptly to both DBS renewal reminder emails.
- Confirm your information and renew your subscription to the Update Service each year.

Online Safeguarding Training Modules

If you are a Club Safeguarding Officer, Coach, Activator, Official, Committee Member, Captain or a parent there is a course available for you. Please click on the course link to register:

Safeguarding Level 1 – SGL1 A free 30-minute online training module provided for anyone, completed when required. ·

Safeguarding Level 2 – SGL2 A free 1-hour interactive online course with an assessment for everyone in a specialist role.
