



Isle of Wight Cricket Board – Parent Code of Conduct

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All parents of IWCB County Age Group Players will:

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person within the context of Cricket
- Treat everyone equally and not discriminate on the grounds of age, gender identity, disability, race, ethnic origin, nationality, colour, parental or marital status, religious belief, class or social background, sexual preference or political belief
- Not condone, or allow to go unchallenged, any form of discrimination if witnessed
- Display high standards of behaviour
- Promote the positive aspects of Cricket, the IWCB, and the 'Spirit of Cricket' at all times
- Encourage all participants to learn the Laws and rules and play within them, respecting the decisions of match officials
- Actively discourage unfair play, rule violations and arguing with match officials
- Recognise good performance not just results
- Place the well-being and safety of children above the development of performance Code of Conduct for parents of county age group players
- Respect and defer to the decisions and expertise of County Managers and County Coaches
- Parents should not enter the dressing room before, during or after training sessions
- Parents should not enter the hall during training sessions unless agreed by the county coaches
- Respect children's opinions when making decisions about their participation in Cricket
- Not provide children with alcohol when they are under the care of the IWCB
- Abide by the ECB and IWCB codes on use of Social Media relating to CAG Cricket at all times
- Follow ECB guidelines set out in the "Safe Hands – Cricket's Policy for Safeguarding Children" and any other relevant guidelines issued
- Report any concerns in relation to a child, following reporting procedures laid down by the ECB
- Inform the IWCB if your child is unable to make a training session or game prior to the agreed start time.
- Inform the IWCB of any change of collection from a training session or match (including other people collecting your child and people that are NOT allowed to collect your child)
