## Isle of Wight Cricket Board – CAG Player Code of Conduct – Agreed by the IWCB Youth Committee

The Isle of Wight Cricket Board is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its players.

It is important that players, coaches, administrators, parents and carers or guardians associated with the County Programme should, always show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Players are encouraged to always be open and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any of their training programme with their County Age Group Coach.

As a player within IWCB County Youth you are expected to abide by the following junior code of conduct:

- You must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- You must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender identity, sexuality, ability, cultural background, or religion.
- You should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform your coach or team manager if you are going to be late.
- You should demonstrate the expected level of behaviour whilst representing the county, both on and off the field, always upholding the 'Spirit of Cricket'.
- You must wear IWCB Youth Cricket kit for all training and match sessions (where possible sensible & safe sportswear where not), as agreed with the coach/team manager.
- You must abide by the ECB and IWCB codes on use of social media relating to CAG Cricket at all times.
- You must not share contact details, photographs, or videos of other players with anyone or online.
- You are not allowed to smoke whilst representing the county.
- You are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind whilst representing the county at training, matches and tours. (Including those who may be legally able to consume alcohol).
- You must follow the instructions of the county coaches at collection time.
