As a home care worker you are required to report any suspected neglect, abuse or exploitation of the people you care for. The following course will outline your responsibilities and how to meet your legal obligations. Thank you for being an advocate for our community!

STATE LAW NOW REQUIRES TRAINING FOR ALL APS MANDATED REPORTERS

Per Maine State Law, (Title 22, 958-A, §3477 8.): Mandated Reporter Training approved by the department must be completed by a person required to make a report under subsection 1, paragraph A, at least once every 4 years. However, some organizations may require it be taken more frequently. It is your responsibility to maintain your certificates and complete the training as often as required by law and your place of employment.
