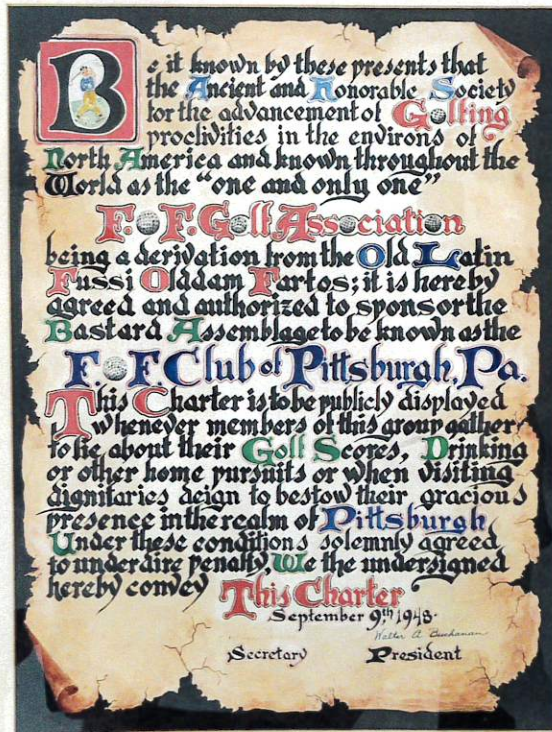

## The History of FOF

The FOF was founded in the New York City area in the 1930's by four engineers associated with the electric utility business. Following WWII, chapters were organized in several cities including Pittsburgh. The Pittsburgh chapter was chartered on September 9, 1948. The original charter is shown below. We were organized under this charter until 2016 when we officially became incorporated in PA.



## Our Purpose

## FOF - Charitable Organization

The FOF is a charitable organization with a long-standing tradition of donating money annually to various local charities and worthy causes. In recent years we have been fortunate enough to be able to donate \$2,000 each to 12 local charities and organizations. Our membership selects these charities and organizations annually based on current needs. Funding for these donations comes from our three annual social events.

## FOF - Sponsored Events

The FOF sponsors three major events each year – a golf outing in the late spring, a clay-shoot during the summer and a dinner dance in the fall.

The golf outing has been a constant throughout the FOF history. Recently the golf outing has been held at the Chestnut Ridge Golf Course in Blairsville. The two courses there and large banquet facilities can accommodate this extremely popular event. This is also our largest fund-raiser of the year.

The clay shoot is a recent event addition. It was added in 2016. The event has become exceptionally popular and has been recently held at the shooting facility at Seven Springs.

In early November we hold a dinner dance. The FOF has sponsored the dinner dance since 1954. Starting in 1960 the event became known as the Oyster Party and was held at the Fort Ligonier Hotel until it was damaged in a fire. It was then moved to the Pittsburgh Athletic Association. In recent times the dinner dance has been held at the Sheraton at Station Square, the Rivers Casino and is currently being held at the LeMont Restaurant on Mt. Washington.
