## 1. Who We Are

## 2. What Information We Collect

We may collect and process the following information:

### Personal Information

- Name
- Date of birth
- Address
- Email address
- Medical conditions
- Telephone number
- Emergency contact details
- Parent or guardian details (for participants under 18)

## Participation Information

- Attendance records
- Team or competition information
- Coaching qualifications and training records
- Medical or accessibility information necessary for participation

## Website and Social Media Information

- Information provided through our website, social media pages or online forms
  - Photographs and videos taken at events (with appropriate consent where required)
- 

## 3. How We Use Your Information

We use your personal information to:

- Administer memberships and registrations.
  - Organise leagues, competitions and events.
  - Deliver coaching courses and community programmes.
  - Communicate important information and updates.
  - Manage safeguarding and welfare responsibilities.
  - Monitor and evaluate projects funded by grant providers.
  - Process payments and maintain financial records.
  - Promote Futnet UK Community Leagues CIC through photographs, videos and social media (subject to consent where required).
  - Comply with legal obligations.

## 4. Lawful Basis for Processing

Under UK GDPR, we process your information on one or more of the following bases:

- **Consent** – where you have given permission.
  - **Contract** – to fulfil our obligations relating to participation or membership.
  - **Legal obligation** – to comply with safeguarding, financial or regulatory requirements.
  - **Legitimate interests** – to manage and develop our activities and services.
  - **Vital interests** – where necessary to protect someone's health or safety.

## 5. Sharing Your Information

We may share non-sensitive information with:

- Coaches, volunteers and staff involved in delivering activities.
- National Governing Bodies and affiliated organisations.
- Funding bodies for monitoring and evaluation purposes.
- Venue providers and event organisers.
- Emergency services where necessary.
- Professional advisers, insurers or regulatory authorities where required by law.

We will never sell your personal information to third parties.

## **6. Photographs and Videos**

Photographs and videos may be taken during training sessions, tournaments and events for:

- Promotion of Futnet UK Community Leagues CIC;
- Social media and website content;
- Funding reports and publicity materials.

Where required, consent will be obtained, particularly for children and young people.

## **7. Data Storage and Security**

We take appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect your personal information from unauthorised access, loss, misuse or disclosure.

Information may be stored electronically and in paper records. Access is limited to authorised personnel and retained only for as long as necessary.

---

## **8. How Long We Keep Your Information**

We retain personal information only for as long as necessary to:

- Deliver our services;
- Meet legal, safeguarding and financial obligations;
- Satisfy funding and reporting requirements.

Information that is no longer required will be securely deleted or destroyed.

---

## 9. Your Rights

Under UK GDPR, you have the right to:

- Access your personal information.
- Request correction of inaccurate information.
- Request deletion of your information (where applicable).
- Restrict or object to processing.
- Withdraw consent at any time where consent is the legal basis.
- Request transfer of your information to another organisation.
- Lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO).

## 11. Children and Young People

We recognise the importance of protecting children's data. Information relating to individuals under 18 will be processed with appropriate safeguards and with the consent of a parent or guardian.
