CHURCH ANNUAL MEETING

The Annual Meeting of the church took place on Sunday, November 6 and was very well attended.

Pastor Tom Conrey and Rev. Rich Miller-Todd gave oral reports to the congregation. The congregation approved the suggested plan for Rev. Kay Miller-Todd to serve as our lead pastor during the Miller-Todd 3-month rotation (assisted by Rev. Rich) beginning in January. Pastor Tom will continue to alternate every 3 months. We love this arrangement!

A summary of our Treasurer's Reports is: General Fund Balance \$305.22, Compassion Fund \$424, Birthday Bag funds \$48.75, Missions and Memorials (including \$5,209 in the roof fund) \$11,012.49, and a CD of \$8,939.04. \$1,000 from savings had to be used for general expenses last year, including heat bills. Total receipts were \$34,131.30 and expenses \$33,892.95. A budget for the coming year was approved in the sum of \$34.975.

Elected to the Board were Lori Holmes and Shirley Holmes (shared 3-year position), Kathy Hansen (3 year position) and Karen Pearce (1 year position). Remaining on the Board are Nelson Pearce, Patti Smith, Jodi Schlenker & Judy Sprague, and Shelly Kern.

Donn Henderson volunteered to construct a "Little Free Pantry." Thanks, Donn! [This would be something like the "Little Free Library" except food and other items would be available for anyone to take what they need.]
