We are to pray that prayer two times a day, every day and learn to add your own petitions to it. I also sent by email the prayer to those not in church. If I missed you, I apologize.

I would also like to hear from you if you have had any results since spending more time with God. If you have a special prayer that you would like to share, I invite you to email it to me and we will use it.

During this past week I was sharing with some folks about the challenge and their response led me to this week's edition. Their response was they did not know how to pray—you know, what do you say? My first response was "whatever is on your heart." First of all you praise God or the many blessings you have—even if they seem trivial.

Now I will teach you a hand/finger prayer.

Start by thanking God, then move on to the fingers. The thumb is closest to us, so pray for those closest to you family and dear friends. Your index finger or pointer finger directs one to pray for those who help us—doctors, teachers, pastors, etc. Then the longest finger/middle finger is to pray for those in leadership, all elected officials, all those holding office within an organization. The ring finger, also known as the weakest finger, reminds us to pray for the weak, those in need, those who are ill those who are suffering. Last but not least is the smallest finger, the pinky finger where we pray for ourselves last.

If you use this guide, as time passes you will naturally just talk with God—about anything you want, and the thing is:
HE WILL LISTEN.

Have a zesty day! When life gives you lemons, make something sweet! You're simply the Zest!

#### LEMON DROP COOKIES

MIX: 1/2 cup butter, with 1 cup sugar.

ADD: 1 egg, 1 tsp vanilla, 2 Tbsp. lemon zest, and 1 Tbsp lemon

juice. Stir to combine.

ADD: 2 1/4 cups flour, 2 tsp baking powder, and 1/4 tsp salt Scoop into 1 inch balls and place on parchment paper-lined baking sheet. Bake for 10 minutes at 350 degrees until cookies are set but not browned. Let cool slightly and then top with glaze:

GLAZE: 2 cups powdered sugar and 2 Tbsp lemon juice.
