Terms, Conditions, and Qualifications:

SPL - 15 years old or 9th grade, Star Scout or higher, Troop member for 6 months, and must attend at least 2/3 of all Troop activities during the term. Completion of NYLT is highly recommended.

ASPL – 15 years old or 9th grade, Star Scout or higher, Troop member for 6 months, completed NYLT, and must attend at least 2/3 of all Troop activities during the term.

JASM – Must be at least 16 years old. Appointed by the Scoutmaster. Performs duties as assigned by the Scoutmaster.

Troop Guide – 1st Class Scout or higher, Troop member for 6 months, completed ILST, completed Troop Guide Training, and must attend at least 50% of all Troop meetings and 50% of Troop camp outs during the term. Sleep and eat with new Scout patrol. Term officially begins at Investiture (31 March 2025) and ends after Winter Camp in 2026.

Patrol Leader – Completed ILST and must attend at least 2/3 of all Troop activities during the term.

Instructor - 1st Class Scout or higher, Troop member for 6 months, completed ILST, and must attend at least 50% of all Troop meetings and 50% of Troop camp outs during the term.

Den Chief – 2nd Class Scout or higher, completed Den Chief Training, completed ILST, must be signed off by Cubmaster, and must attend 50% of BOTH Den and Troop activities during the term.

Outdoor Ethics Guide – 1st Class Scout or higher, Troop member for 6 months, completed ILST, and must attend at least 1/2 of all Troop activities during the term.

Quartermaster – 2nd Class Scout or higher and must attend at least 2/3 of all Troop activities during the term.

Chaplain Aide – 2nd Class Scout or higher and must attend at least 1/2 of all Troop activities during the term.

Web Master – 2nd Class Scout or higher and must attend at least 1/2 of all Troop activities during the term.

Scribe – 2nd Class Scout or higher and must attend at least 2/3 of all Troop activities during the term.

Historian – 2nd Class Scout or higher and must attend at least 1/2 of all Troop activities during the term.

Librarian – 2nd Class Scout or higher and must attend at least 1/2 of all Troop activities during the term.

OA Representative – Must be a member of the Order of the Arrow in good standing, attend at least 1/2 of OA Chapter meetings, and 1/2 of all Troop activities during the term.
