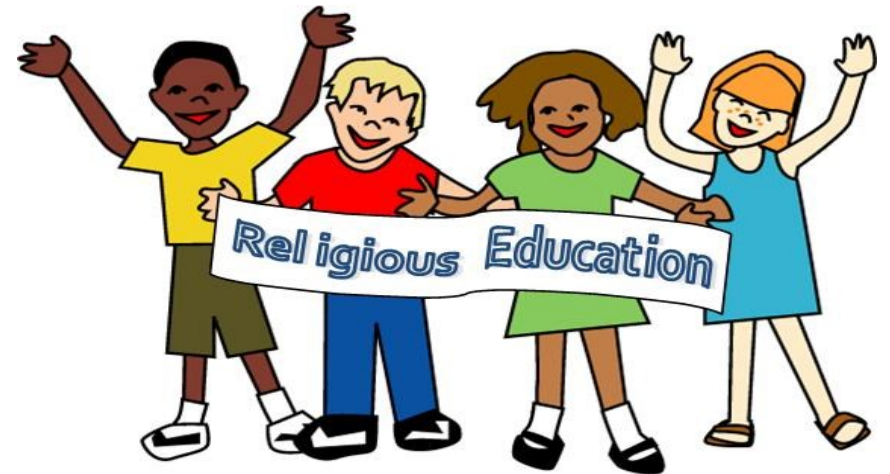


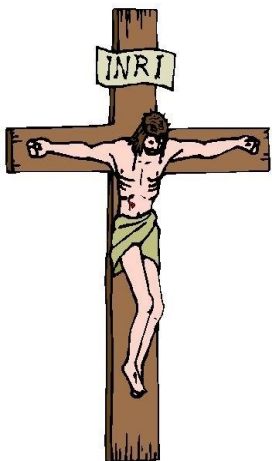

Apostles.

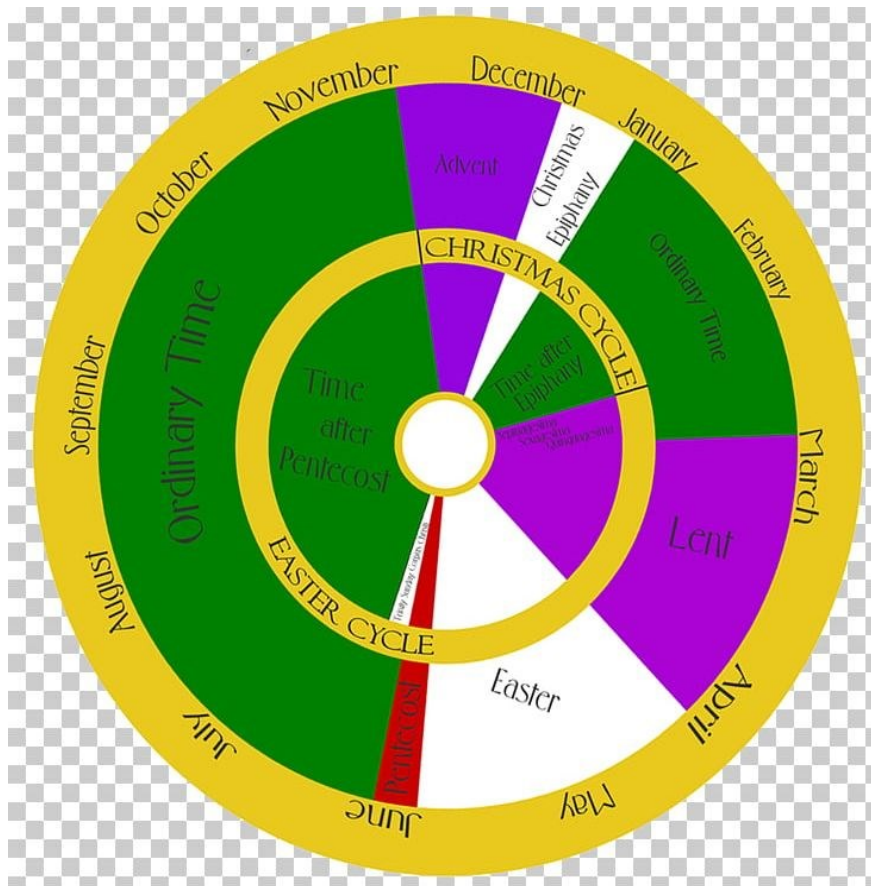
ASCENSION: Jesus Ascends to His

THE HAIL MARY

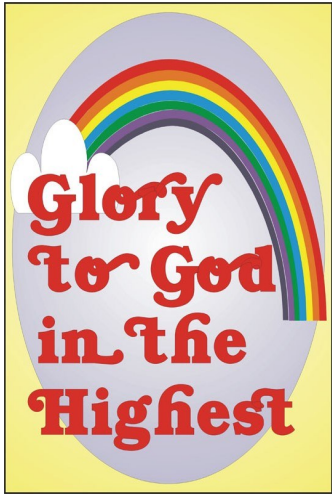
Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee; blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb Jesus.

THE HOLY MASS

On the Cross Jesus Offered His Body and Blood to God the Father for us. In the Mass this great act is renewed for our benefit. We offer Jesus to God the Father in Adoration, Thanksgiving and Reparation and Petition. We receive Jesus back from the Father as our Bread for Eternal Life. We sing Hymns to praise God and to show our joy at Mass.



MAJOR PARTS OF THE HOLY MASS

Introductory Rites: We speak to God in Acts of Contrition, Praise and Petition.



Liturgy of the Word: We listen to what God says to us in the Readings, the Gospel, and the Homily.

LITURGY OF THE EUCHARIST



Preparation of the Gifts: With the Priest we present the gifts of bread and wine.



Eucharist Prayer: At the Consecration, this Bread and Wine are changed into the Body and Blood of Jesus.
