

Heavenly Father.


PENTECOST: Jesus sends the Holy Spirit.

THE HAIL MARY


Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee; blessed art thou among women and blesses is the fruit of thy womb Jesus.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. AMEN.


